ABOUT THE PROGRAM

Teachers consistently indicate that effective classroom behavior management is one of their primary occupational concerns. Whether it is within the range of passive-aggressive, non-compliance to overt disruption or bullying, teachers need a menu of strategies to deal with these at-risk children.

With the advent of Response to Intervention (RtI), the approach to behavior management may fit well within a tiered approach. Within an RtI model, universal behavioral management strategies that apply to all students, targeted interventions for at-risk students, and indicated interventions for students identified as having serious behavioral challenges would be organized across a continuum of school-based intervention.

The workshop will go beyond describing effective approaches and focus on the process of maintaining gains, facilitating teacher and staff buy-in, and describing strategies for working with the most difficult-to-reach students and families. Workshop attendees will also have an opportunity to network and discuss current issues with a professional learning community of administrators.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND

This program is designed for teachers and administrators, including directors of special education, assistants for curriculum and instruction, school psychologists and counselors, department chairs, principals/assistant principals, and deans.

ABOUT THE PRESENTER

Greg Fabiano, Ph.D. is an assistant professor of Counseling, School and Educational Psychology in the Graduate School of Education at the University at Buffalo. His interests are in the area of evidence-based assessments and treatments for children with attention-deficit/hyperactivity disorder (ADHD). He is the author or co-author on 30 peer-reviewed publications and 8 book chapters. He has received federal funding from his work from multiple agencies. Dr. Fabiano was a recipient of the Presidential Early Career Award for Scientists and Engineers, the nation's highest honor for early career investigators.
